Human Services

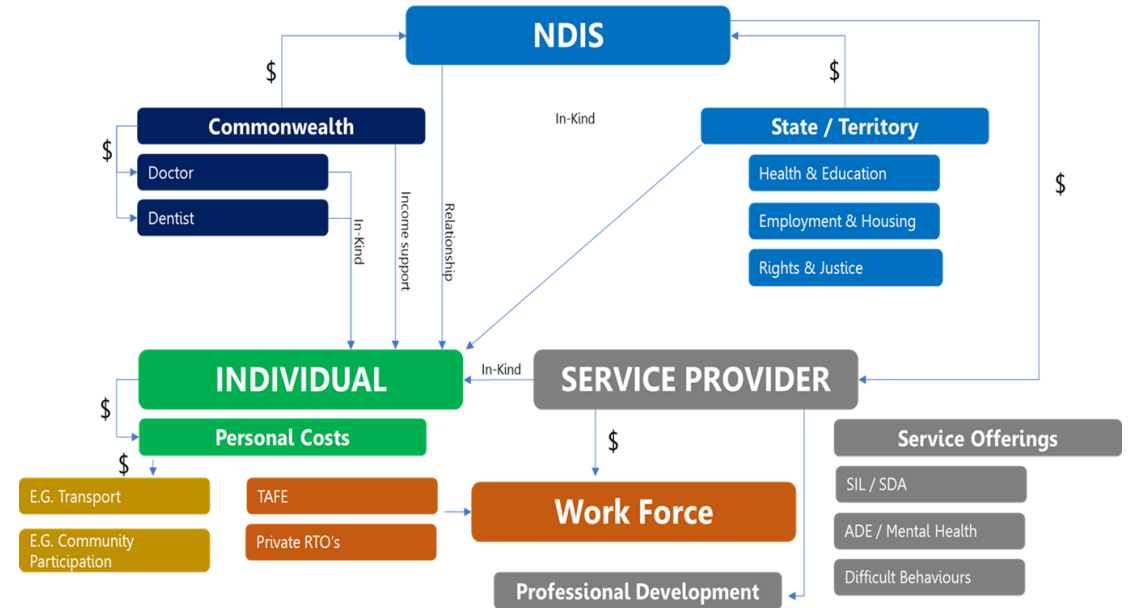
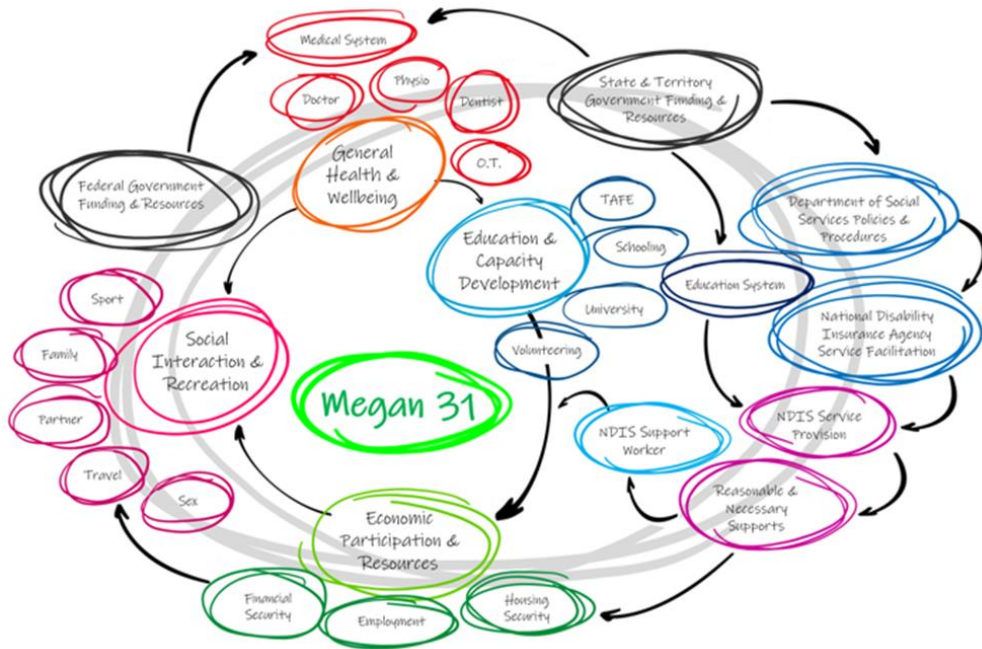
- Long Term: consistency & reliability are critical
- Critical for economic and social engagement
- Impacts natural supports
- Economically very significant: employment; economic engagement; consumption
- Highly heterogenous
- Negatively impacted by constitutional settlement



NDIS Policy Challenges

- Politics – the problem of unanimity & stakeholder domination
- Politics – the problem of talking about the NDIS
- Structure – gap between decision making and service delivery
- Cost – capping & means testing; cost shifting; vertical fiscal imbalance
- Under Capitalisation
- Economics – quasi markets & consumer sovereignty; utilisation tells the story
- Service delivery – one-size-does-not-fit-all
- Sustainability & transparency

Macro v Micro – Components v Systems

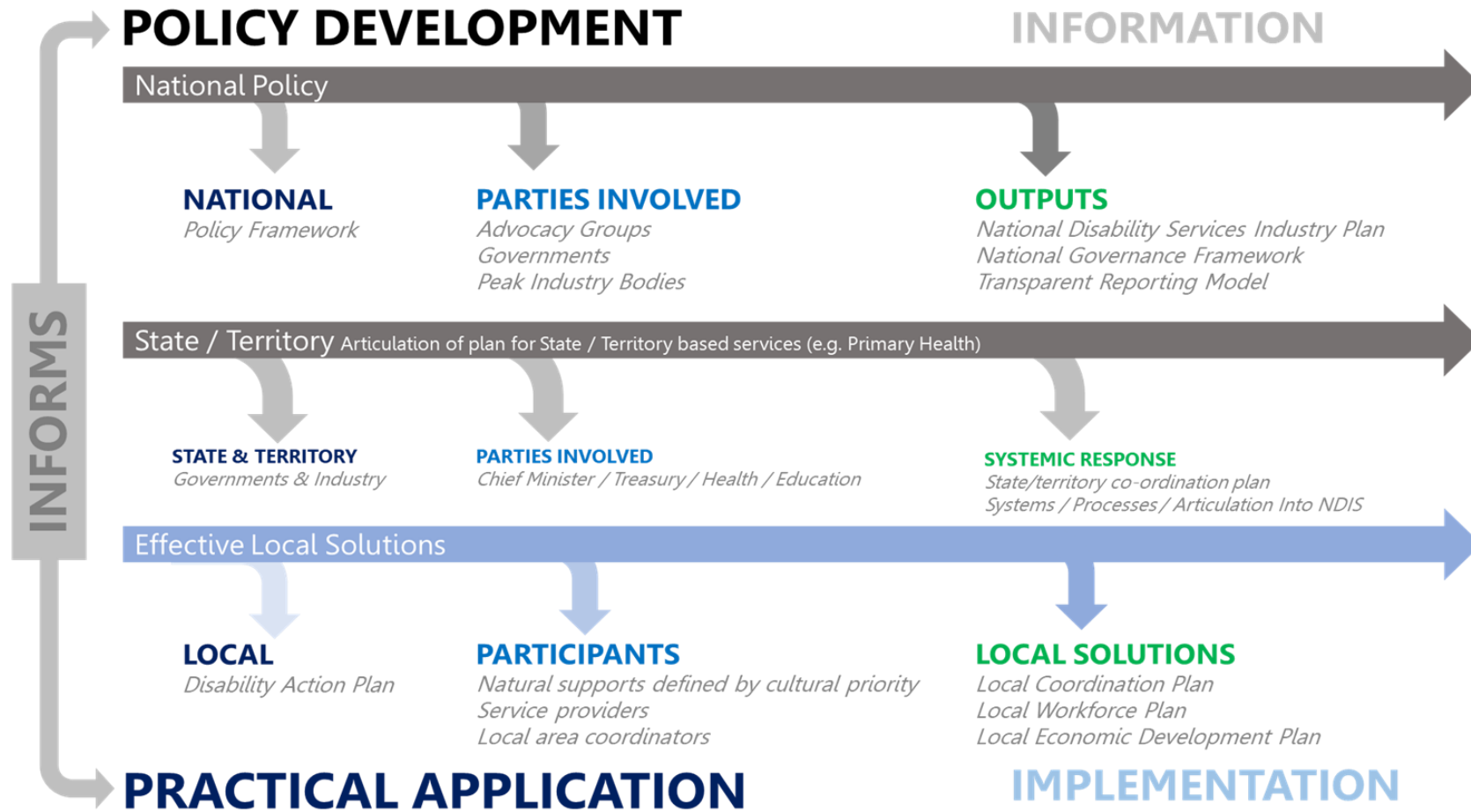
